Joint call

This is a joint call by the French National Observatory of Poverty and Social Exclusion (Onpes) and the "Plan Urbanisme Construction and Architecture" (Puca), a French inter-ministerial service created in 1998 in order to encourage and coordinate research programs in the fields of urban development, housing, construction and architecture. The French national Observatory of Poverty and Social Exclusion carries out research on poverty and related issues.

Background

In recent years there has been an increasing focus on poor housing, but the costs of homelessness and the economic and social cost of poor housing remain unknown in France.

Overall goal

The overall goal is to support research in order to estimate the social and economic impact of poor housing

Research area

The Call consists of two parts: the first one is compulsory and, the second one is optional. The first part consists of constructing/building up an elaborate method and the second one aims at putting a cost at poor housing.
